Vanzarapura Village

Bhenaji lost his right foot in a road accident. To defecate, he had to crawl to an open space, and reported encountering many poisonous insects. Life was difficult for Bhenaji, but today he expresses “noble support of Share & Care.”



Alindra Village

Solanki Gotabhai Pasabhai, 63 and physically challenged, lives with his wife (shown above, alongside their new indoor toilet) and works as a laborer. They had no alternative to open defecation. Today they say they are “the happiest people.”



Chadotar Village

Parmar Narsinhbhai Dharmaji is a Scheduled Caste family of seven, including his wife (shown above). Before their indoor toilet, they used the village pond and were bitten twice by dogs. Today Parmar expresses his gratitude through tears of happiness.
