### **Women Empowerment | WE**

Geeta Rana and her husband are both physically challenged, making it difficult to provide for themselves and their two children. They have faced financial hardships in the past, and have often been unable to afford food. With the help of our WE program, Geeta received vocational training and resources to become a seamstress — allowing her to earn a steady income even with restricted mobility. **She is now able to support her family and provide an education for her children, as well.** ([Learn more about WE.](#))



### **Educate 2 Success | E2S**

Namita Adhikari is a 10th-grade student who has been enrolled in our E2S program for three years. When we met her, she

### **Educate 2 Graduate | E2G**

### **Nirmal Village Program | NVP**

NVP provides toilets and sanitation education to individuals living in remote areas of rural India. The Laxmans, who live in the Banas Kantha district of Gujarat, are a family of eight who live on meager earnings from seasonal farm labor. One daughter is blind, and another is handicapped. Twenty-four-year-old Sunita was eight months pregnant and anemic the first time she received a medical checkup. In her remote village, healthcare had always been scarce and difficult to access.
