Our Women Empowerment program annually hosts "Cooking for a Cause," a cooking competition that is usually held at a public venue with pay-to-enter access. When the WE committee had to cancel the event due to COVID-19, Shaun Mehtani, owner of Mehtani Restaurant Group, allowed us to use the funding given for the venue to help distribute

food.

On January 7, we contributed to two deliveries of 60 meals to REAL HOUSE, a women's shelter located in Wanaque, NJ and West Milford, NJ.

On January 14, Share & Care donated food to 40 people at the Market Street Mission in Morristown, NJ, as well as providing canned goods and bread.

Lastly, we partnered with Manavi, a NJ-based organization with a mission to end all forms of violence against women. We distributed 20 meal gift cards (worth \$35 each) from Moghul Restaurant amongst women and children of South Asian origin who are survivors of domestic violence.
