The Saamarthya Project, supported by our Women Empowerment Signature Program, works to empower girls in the states of Kashmir and Gujarat to become independent — financially, intellectually, and emotionally. The project's goal is to train and empower enough young women to become community leaders that will have a rippling impact on society as a whole.

To do so, the Saamarthya Project hosts a variety of camps at schools to conduct workshops on a number of topics related to women empowerment, such as increasing self confidence, self-defense, fighting discrimination, and developing leadership skills. **The girls in attendance unlock their hidden potential and go back to their communities as transformed individuals, more confident, responsible, and independent.**

Additionally, the camps identify young leaders who receive further education, mentorship, and additional opportunities to foster their burgeoning skills. The project further supports these young women until they reach their goals and become thriving, independent women in their communities.
