



PANDEMIC DISASTER RELIEF: HOW WE'RE HELPING

Humanity is facing an invisible but real viral enemy — the COVID-19 pandemic, which knows no boundaries and affects all irrespective of race, religion, creed, or social status.

Recently, we announced an allocation of \$100,000 in disaster relief funds to provide support to those affected by this ongoing health (and resulting financial) crisis.

The first phase of this project will provide 1,000 grocery kits to India's poorest day wage earners and their families, who are now facing sudden unemployment due to government lockdowns.

The kits, which cost about \$15 each, will be distributed by our NGO partners and Gandhi Ashram team members who are working on the ground in rural India.
