Kids4Kids Race to Change Futures, Leave Their Legacy

This summer, members of the Share & Care Kids4Kids (K4K) group traveled to Light of Life Trust's (LOLT) Worli location to educate 40 students in computer science skills. The team of eight, led by Rhea Shah, included Rehan Shah, Shivam Modani, Rhyan Maru, Aarav Gandhi, Arhaan Gandhi, Soha Mehta, and Yuvraj Mehta.

Together, the volunteers taught the students at LOLT how to use Google Docs, Google Sheets, Google Slides, Microsoft Word, and Canva. In addition to computer science skills, the volunteers taught different forms of art to provide a well-rounded experience for each student. One form of art, abstract cubism, allowed the students to be creative when drawing self-portraits using different shapes in order to define their facial features.

To express their gratitude for the opportunity to teach at LOLT, the eight members split the cost of purchasing a school bag for each of the 40 students and sponsoring them in an upcoming marathon fundraiser. To thank the team, a few students handmade cards to give to the volunteers

For the volunteer team, the experience has inspired them to become even more involved with Share & Care's Signature Programs, continuing the legacy of service across generations.
