The son of a cobbler and housewife, **John Peter's future was uncertain despite excelling in high school**. He searched for ways to support his dream of studying engineering and learned about E2G through partner NGO Kalanjyam Trust. Though his application was nearly waitlisted due to high demand, John Peter impressed the interviewers with his potential and was awarded the scholarship.

Three years later, John Peter continues to excel in his engineering course, funded by the E2G scholarship. Additionally, he actively participates in workshops and hands-on projects in robotics and has shown strong leadership qualities. John Peter and his family are deeply grateful for the E2G scholarship, **considering it a blessing that has significantly contributed to his education and their family's overall development**.

The daughter of a wage laborer and housewife, **Shamina Begum** overcame both societal and financial obstacles to continue her schooling after applying for an E2G scholarship. "In our community, many families do not allow their daughters to pursue higher education. My own relatives were against my continuing to study, but my father was determined to ensure I received a good education."

Shamina is inspired to make a difference in the lives of others, just as E2G made a difference for her. "The E2G scholarship made it possible for me to complete my B.Sc. I am passionate about continuing my studies, so I have now joined an M.Sc. Microbiology program. **I am deeply grateful to those who have supported me, and I am committed to making a difference in society.** My goal is to help other students, especially girls, continue their education and achieve their dreams."
