## Cut Off from Care

The villages of Manipur are remote, difficult to reach, and have few means of transportation. The roads to the villages are narrow, unfinished, and blocked by boulders and pits, and the village inhabitants are farmers and daily wage earners with low socioeconomic status. No health facilities are available, and outreach services do not visit the area. Without accessible healthcare, they live unaware of simple ways to protect their health and the health of their children.



## Creating Healthy Beginnings

Since 2019, Share & Care, in partnership with the Rural Health Organization (RHO), has been working tirelessly to change this reality. We've committed to serving the nearly 21,000 people in 14 villages in Manipur, providing critical services to newborns, mothers, and families who desperately need our help. Our program goals include:

- **100% of pregnant women** receive prenatal care and a tetanus vaccination
- **10% of nursing mothers** receive postnatal care
- **80% of children** receive routine immunizations
- **70% of pregnant women** have their deliveries in a healthcare facility
- **80% of the rural population** receive essential preventative healthcare services
- **80% of eligible couples** incorporate any of the family planning methods
- **80% of the rural community** is aware of hygiene and health education
- **100% of cases** with severe acute emergencies are referred to health facilities
