

Mourning Victims of the Attack in Kashmir



In response to the attack in the Pahalgam area of Kashmir, which killed 26 people, Share & Care's Disaster Relief Committee held an emergency meeting with the Board of Trustees and Committee Chairs to offer support and act in response.



A resolution was unanimously approved stating that,

"Everyone at the Foundation is saddened by the news of the loss of innocent lives and shares in the grief of their families, friends, and the entire nation. Share & Care stands strongly united with the affected families and India. We will do our very best to support the healing of these devastating wounds."

Dr. Ketki Shah, Women Empowerment Chair, has contacted a partner NGO working in Kashmir to open communication in case needs arise in response to this tragedy. Our members have also contacted local NGOs that are in touch with the affected families to convey our condolences and moral support.

Gathering in Grief and Support

At the emergency meeting, we requested members to hold a vigil with their families, neighbors and friends. Share & Care members gathered to mourn and demonstrate solidarity with the victims and the nation. A vigil prayer meeting was held at the home of Ketki and Sharad with roughly 20 neighbors and friends. Attendees were in deep emotion, expressing their grief at the tragic loss of innocent life.

Share & Care members Jayu and Dilip Parikh, residents of Livingston, also attended a candlelight vigil alongside hundreds of mourners in their community.
