This week at Paris Haute Couture Fashion Week, designer Manish Malhotra debuted a collection featuring chikankari — a delicate hand-stitching technique originating in India — from the

women at Mijwan Welfare Society, in Uttar Pradesh, a Share & Care Women's Empowerment partner led by chair Dr. Ketki Shah. One piece took over 11 months to hand-embroider.

For over three decades, the Share & Care Foundation has partnered with and funded MWS, which is spearheaded by Shabana Azmi, to drive female empowerment, vocational training, and livelihood independence in remote villages. We've funded the resources, equipment, and stability that helped them scale to where they are today. Among the beneficiaries is Neelu Prajapati, who used her training to support her family through a difficult season.
